As the former Canadian Defence Attaché to The Netherlands, I had the great honour of participating in many remembrance ceremonies to pay tribute to Canadian soldiers and aviators buried in The Netherlands. I quickly learned that the Dutch people are incredible caretakers of our war dead, making it part of their culture to remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice for their freedom.
